Job Description



Position Summary

The Youth and Family Minister, in partnering with parents and guardians, is tasked with developing, nurturing, and equipping the faith of the students of the Boerne Church of Christ. This full-time position will work in conjunction with staff, elders, deacons, and volunteers to develop vision and programs in order to foster disciples of Jesus. The Youth and Family Minister is accountable to the Elders and will work under the supervision of the Preaching Minister.

Who We Are:

- A prayerful and Bible-based congregation located between the San Antonio metro area and Texas Hill Country
- Regularly 200-250 Sunday worship attendance
- Led by 6 shepherds, 13 deacons, and ministry staff
- Family-focused, with intentional emphasis on inter-generational connections
- Rich tradition of a cappella singing
- A rapidly growing congregation in a rapidly growing community

Our Youth Group Is:

- Close-knit and highly relational
- Warm, welcoming, and open to new-comers
- Encouraging of student leadership within the group and larger congregation
- Scripturally knowledgeable

Essential Duties:

- Mentor the youth in their relationship with Jesus Christ
- Impart a knowledge and love of Scripture to our congregation's Middle and High School students (6th-12th grade)
- Oversee the curriculum and teaching of youth Bible classes
- Cultivate a culture of discipleship within the church body
- Develop and promote relationships within the body
- Be an ambassador for Christ in the community of Boerne
- Ensure a healthy and safe environment for all youth classes and activities
- Be involved in the lives of the youth and their families through hospitality, fellowship, and attendance to extra-curricular activities, as available
- Oversee the event calendar for the youth ministry including LTC, camps, mission trips, retreats, devotionals, and other activities
- Identify needs and develop new ministry responses as the youth ministry changes over time
- Provide support for the children's ministry as needed
- Maintain a preaching and teaching presence in the congregation, with a maximum of ten preaching opportunities per year

- Collaborate with other leaders to organize activities that encourage youth family involvement, the inclusion of new members and visitors, and nurture church unity
- Utilize new or updated techniques to communicate effectively with students and families
- Abide by the Elders' office guidelines
- Responsibly develop and manage the youth ministry budget
- Maintain reasonable office hours
- Participate in staff meetings
- Other duties as needs arise

Minimum Requirements:

- Baptized believer and disciple of Jesus Christ
- Active member in and understanding of the Church of Christ tradition
- A healthy, God-centered marriage (if married)
- Extensive understanding and love of Scripture
- Proven track record of successfully leading and inspiring students
- Good verbal, written, and presentation skill
- Ability to prepare and deliver compelling and effective classes

Preferred Candidates Will Have:

- Undergraduate degree in Ministry/Bible or related field
- Two years of full-time youth ministry experience
